Questions

1. Ps. Ray gave us the illustration of milk vs. solid foods. We should be growing in discipleship and relationship with the Lord. In comparison with the baby food where do you find yourself? How do you take the next step? (Ex: Milk, baby food, solids, steak?)
2. Ps. Ray said many Christians get stuck spiritually drinking "milk" out of old habit. What is a habit you need to let go of to continue your growth in Christ?
3. Ps. Ray said, "Growth is measured by fruit, not by time." Put this statement in your own words (be prepared to share). How does this revelation change your perspective on growth? On time?
4. How is God inviting you, right now, to deepen your dependence on the Holy Spirit (i.e. praying before action, yielding in conflict, embracing spiritual disciplines, etc.)?
