Sermon Series: The Book of Revelation

Sermon: You've Abandoned Your First Love

Icebreaker: What is something you loved doing when you were younger that you haven't done in a long time? (It can be funny, riding bikes, playing basketball, drawing, fishing, going to the movies, whatever)

Big Thought: Sometimes we don't make a decision to stop doing something we love. Life just gets busy, priorities shift, and slowly we drift away from it. Jesus tells the church in Ephesus something similar happened in their relationship with Him."

Quick Review: What stood out to you most from what you heard or read in this weekend's message?

Scripture: Revelation 2:4-5 - "But I have this against you: You have abandoned the love you had at first. Remember then how far you have fallen; repent, and do the works you did at first."

Questions

1. What do you think it looks like practically for someone to be doing things for Jesus but slowly drifting away from Jesus?
2. What are some signs that your relationship with Jesus is becoming routine instead of relational?
3. Jesus gives three words: Remember, Repent, Return. Which one of those speaks to you most right now, and why?
4. What is one thing you used to do in your relationship with God that helped keep your heart close to Him? (ie. Prayer? Worship? Reading Scripture? Quiet time? Serving? Something else?)
