A Holy Moment

Sermon Series: That's Crazy. No, That's God!

Icebreaker: Share a "hummingbird moment": When God showed up to answer a prayer.

Quick Review: What stood out to you most from what you heard or read in this weekend's message?

Main Idea: Jesus should be our pursuit. Consecrate your life and run into His presence.

Scripture: Exodus 33:1-6, 15-23

Questions

1. Ps. Todd said if a door opens and it looks promising, but you don't take God with you, it won't last. Think about a time when you pursued an opportunity you felt was from God, but you didn't "take Him with you?" (i.e. you did it your way and didn't involve Him, you were distracted by the opportunity and lost focus on Him, etc.). Share what happened.
2. "When you stop cultivating your garden (i.e. your relationship with God), weeds will grow." What does your "garden" look like? What are some practices you can implement to keep your garden free of weeds?
3. Ps. Todd said we are too busy chasing the hand of God, that we miss relationship with Him. Think about a prayer you are believing God for, something you really want God to answer. How will you respond if He doesn't answer the way you want Him to? Explain.
4. Ps. Todd said be excited about what God is doing in your life right now! He said learn to see Him in everything. Share one thing God is doing in your life that you are excited about.
